

Centron Group has completed the lease of its first major tenant in its underconstruction Centre 10 building.

The National Energy Board will move into approximately 150,000 square feet on four floors above the main floor retail podium that boasts a terrace balcony on the second level.

Centre 10 was remodelled by NORR Architects from the original two tower condo development into a 10-storey office block of 355,000 square feet. Aboveground construction is headed toward the third floor already, with support columns for the second and third levels already in place.

Michael Anderson, vice-president of commercial development, says the tight vacancy and availability of premium office in the downtown has resulted in many inquiries about the remaining 185,000 square feet of space in Centre 10.

Occupancy is scheduled for the second quarter of 2013.
